Dear Parents,

 - ❖ **Select books with repetitive text as repetition encourages comprehension.**



- ❖ While reading / assisted reading make connections by asking questions and talking about the text.
- ❖ Help them visualize the story, make predictions and draw inferences.
- ❖ Make reading a leisure time fun activity so as to spark a love for reading.
- ❖ Remember: Reading and Writing are complementary skills and children who read widely become better readers.

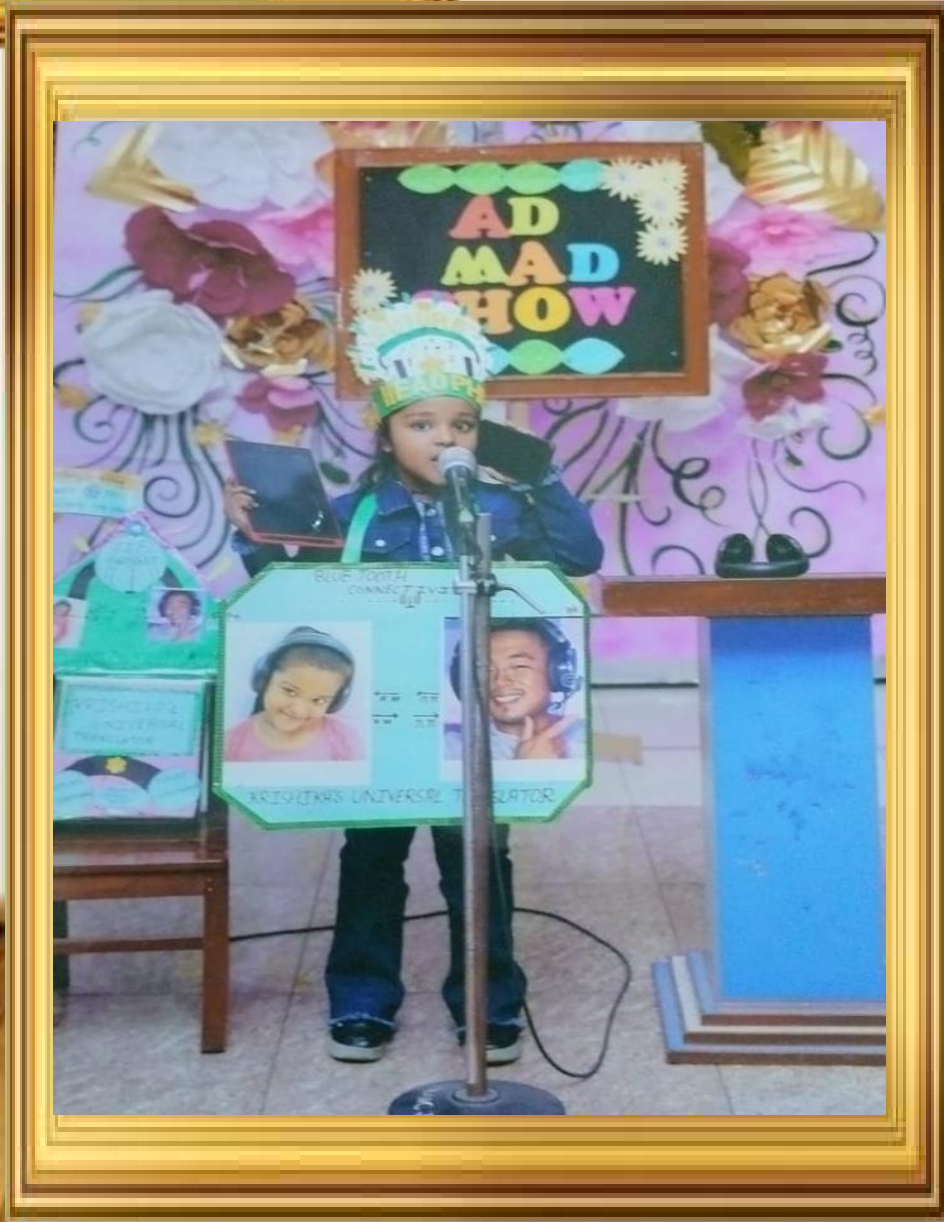
