

# **SMALLPOX**

Smallpox is an eradicated virus that used to be contagious, disfiguring and often deadly.

The smallpox vaccine, introduced by Edward Jenner in 1796, was the first successful vaccine to be developed. He observed that milkmaids who previously had caught cowpox did not catch smallpox and showed that inoculated vaccinia protected against inoculated Variola virus.

FDA licensed smallpox (Vaccinia) Vaccine, Live with the proprietary name ACAM 2000. The smallpox vaccine is no longer available to the public. In 1980, WHO declared smallpox was eliminated.



# YELLOW FEVER

Yellow fever is a serious disease caused by a virus that is spread through the bite of an infected mosquito.

In 1951, Max Theiler of the Rockefeller Foundation received the Nobel Prize in Medicine for the discovery of an effective vaccine against yellow fever. This was the first and so far the only, Nobel Prize given for the development of a virus vaccine.



#### **HUMAN PAPILLOMA**

HPV vaccines prevent infection by certain types of Human Papilloma Virus (HPV). All vaccines protect against atleast HPV types 16 and 18, which cause the greatest risk of cervical cancer.


The vaccine was first developed at the University of Queensland, Georgetown University Medical Center, University of Rochester and the US National Cancer Institute. Researchers Ian Frazer and Jian Zhou at the University of Queensland have been accorded priority under US patent law for the invention of HPV Vaccine's basis. In 2006 the FDA approved the first preventive HPV Vaccine.



# **CHICKENPOX**

Chickenpox is a highly contagious viral infection which causes an itchy, blister like rash on the skin. It is caused by Varicella Zoster Virus. A live, attenuated varicella vaccine was developed in Japan in the 1970's from virus isolated by Michiaki Takahashi from vesicular fluid from an otherwise healthy child with varicella disease. Varicella vaccine was licensed for general use in Japan and Korea in 1988, and in the United States in 1995 for persons age 12 months or older.

#### **HEPATITIS**

HEPATITIS refers to an inflammatory condition of the liver. In 1973, Dr. Wolfgang Szmusness, a Polish/Jewish emigre from the Soviet Union collaborated with Dr. Saul Krugman of New York University to develop a vaccine. The vaccine was approved in 1981. In 1986, research began on second generation of vaccines that do not use human serum, and the first vaccine was discontinued in 1990.

Hepatitis A vaccine history started with its development in 1995, which resulted in a decline in this virus occurrence after a peak number of cases in 1995. Two types of hepatitis A vaccines are available- the inactivated and the live attenuated vaccine. Hepatitis B vaccination is a series of three vaccines typically completed over the first 6 months of childhood.



# **MMR**

MMR vaccine is used against measles, mumps and rubella. These are the viral infections spread through the air by respiratory droplets. The first dose is generally given to children around 9 months to 15 months of age, with a second dose at 15 months to 6 years of age with atleast four weeks between the doses.

It was developed by Maurice Hilleman. It was licensed for use in USA by Merck in 1971. Stand alone measles, mumps and rubella vaccines had been previously licensed in 1963, 1967 and 1969 respectively.



# **RABIES**

Rabies is a deadly virus belonging to Lyssavirus genus which spreads from the saliva of infected animals.

Two french scientists, **Louis Pasteur** and **Emile Roux**, developed the first rabies vaccination in 1885. Nine year old Joseph Meister (1876-1940), who had been mauled by a rabid dog, was the first human to receive this vaccine.

The rabies vaccine can be used to prevent rabies before and for a period of time after exposure to the rabies virus



### HAEMOPHILUS INFLUENZAE

Haemophilus influenzae most often cause pneumonia, but can also cause severe illnesses like meningitis, bloodstream infections, Epiglottitis, Arthritis and Ear infections.

The first vaccine against Hib disease was licensed in the United States in 1985.

American Scientists John Robbins, MD and Rachel Schneerson, MD led to the first conjugate vaccine against Hib disease being licensed in the US (1987). Conjugate Vaccines are better able to induce an immune response

Hib vaccine is very effective and routinely given throughout the US.

DPT Vaccine or DTP vaccine is a class of combination vaccines against three infectious disease in humans: diptheria, pertussis (whooping cough) and tetanus. The vaccine components include diptheria and tetanus toxoids.

# **POLIO**

Polio is a disabling and life-threatening disease caused by the poliovirus. In 1955, Dr. Jonas Salk developed the first vaccine against polio-an injectable, inactivated polio vaccine. In 1961, Dr. Albert Sabin developed a "live" Oral Polio Vaccine (OPV) which rapidly became the vaccine of choice for most national immunization programmes globally. Only IPV has been used in the United States since 2000. Oral Poliovirus vaccine is still used throughout the world.



# **PNEUMOCOCCAL**

Pneumococcal disease is common in young children but older adults are at greatest risk of serious illness and death. In US, there are 2 kinds of vaccines: Pneumococcal conjugate vaccine (PCV13), Pneumococcal polysaccharide vaccine (PPSV23).

Merck licensed a polysaccharide vaccine protecting against 14 types of pneumococcal bacteria in 1977. In 1983, Merck expanded on this work by producing a vaccine against 23 types of pneumococcal bacteria.

This vaccine protects against serious and potentially fatal pneumococcal infections.
