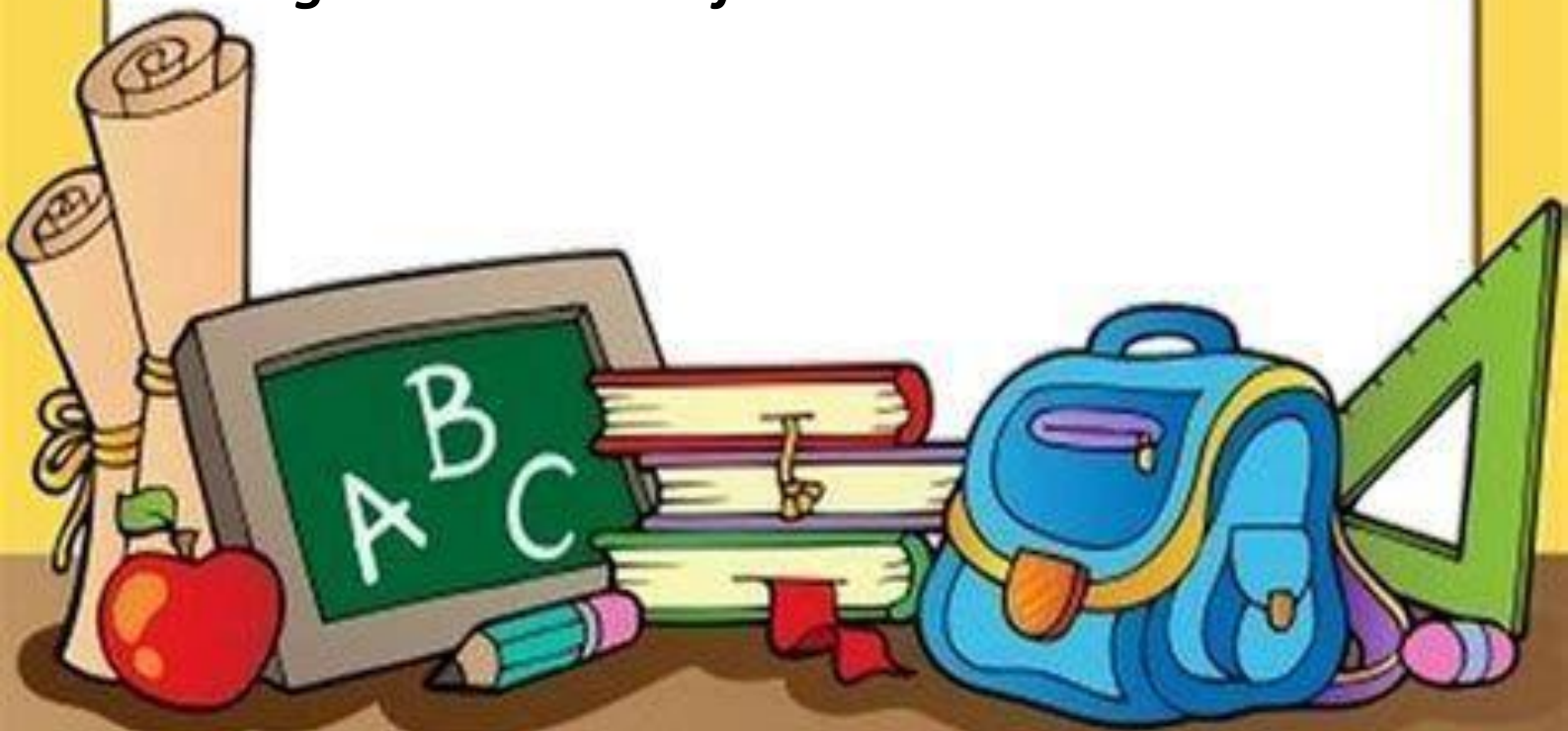

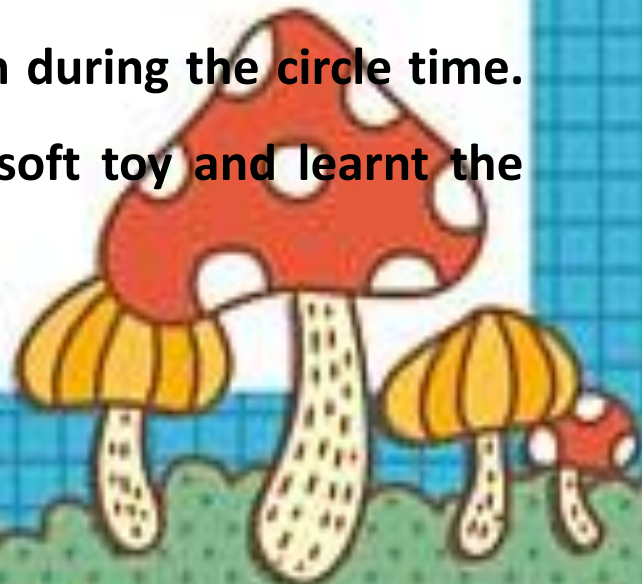




Activities

MEANINGFUL WAYS TO ENGAGE KIDS DURING SUMMER VACATIONS

- Keep it simple: Young children learn best through hands-on activities and play. Keep learning activities simple, age-appropriate and fun. Use everyday objects such as building blocks, balls, and household items to create learning opportunities.
- Encourage sensory play: Sensory play engages all five senses of young children, which enhances their learning and development.
