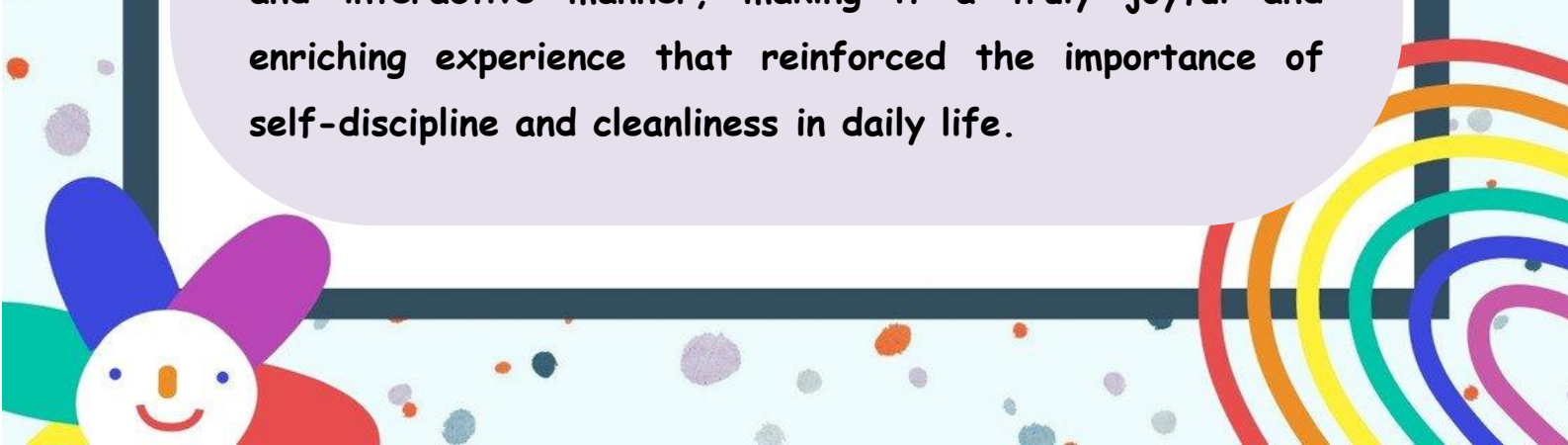
Highlights

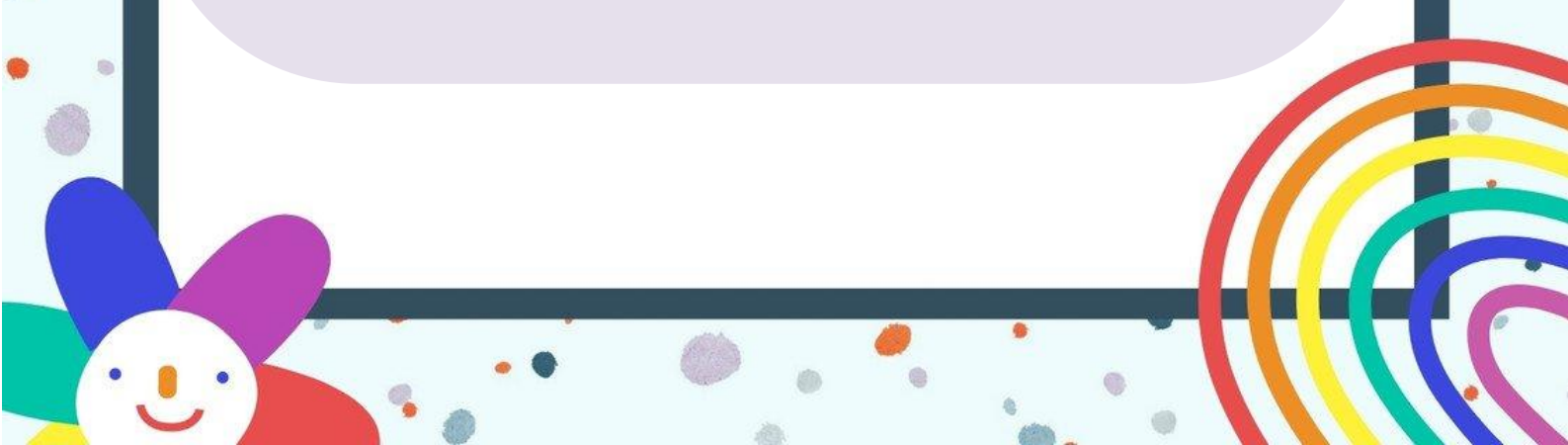


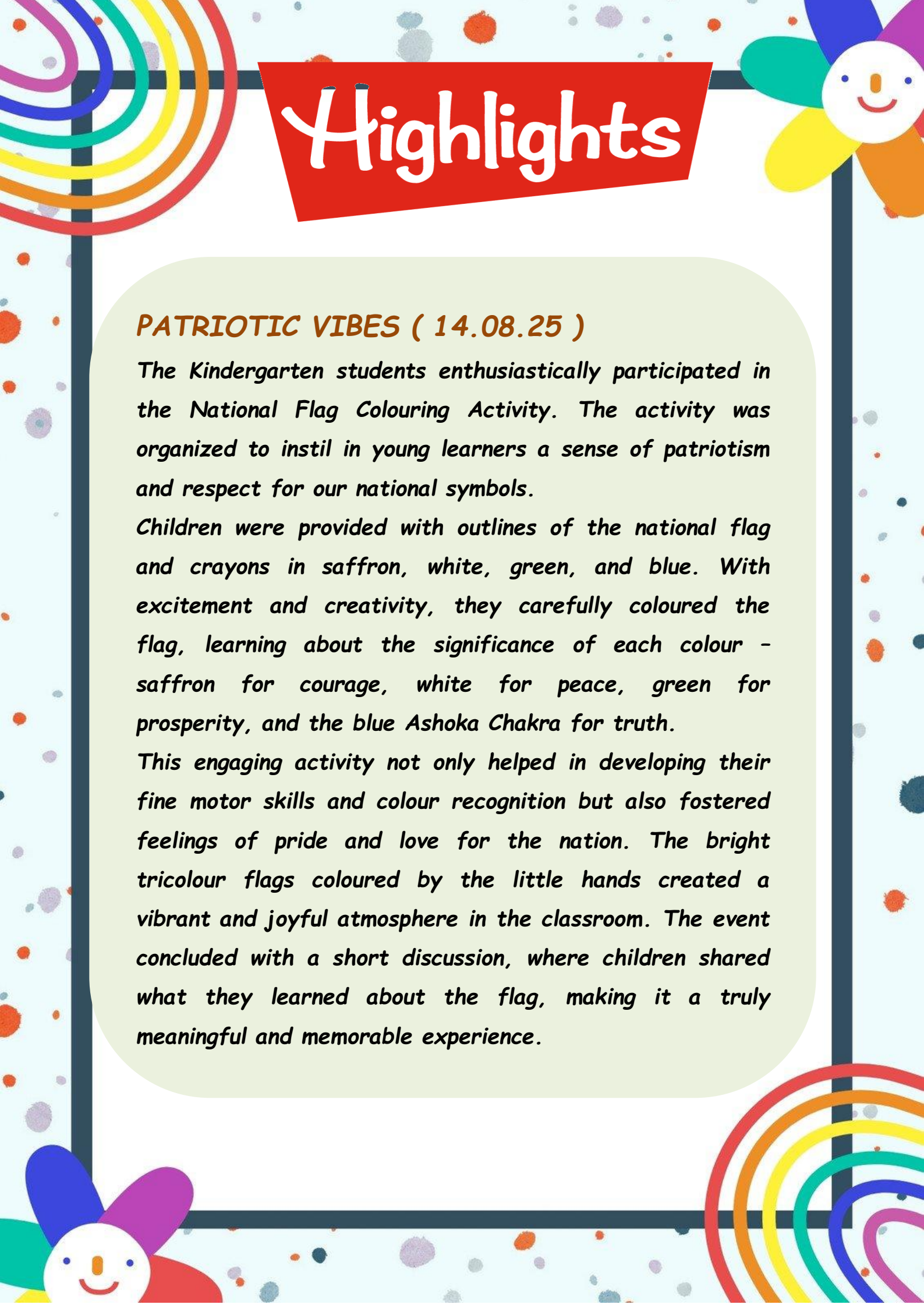
Highlights

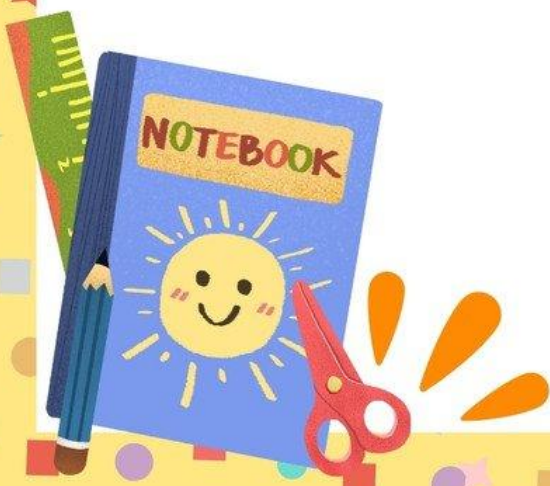
