## **TRAFFIC TYKES ACTIVITY**

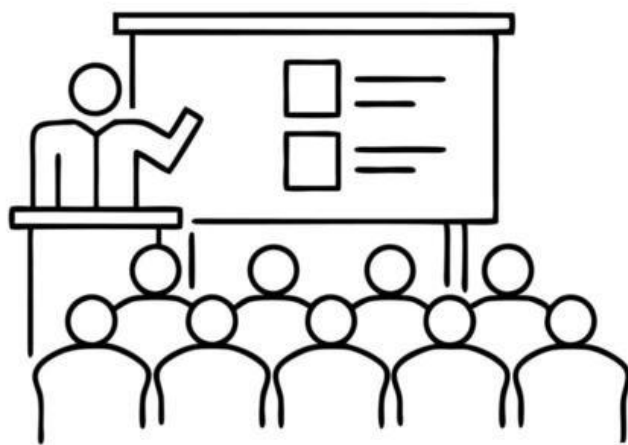

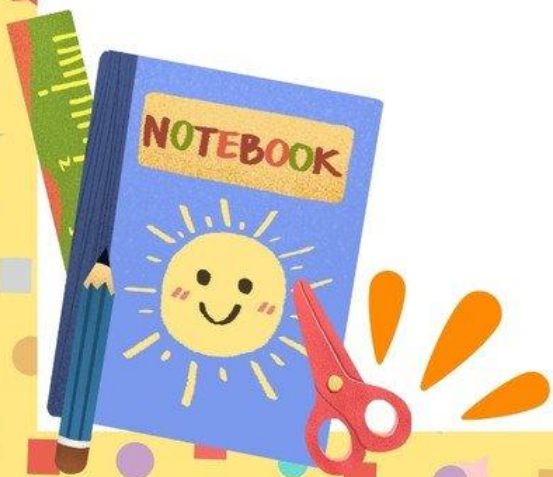


# IMPORTANT
