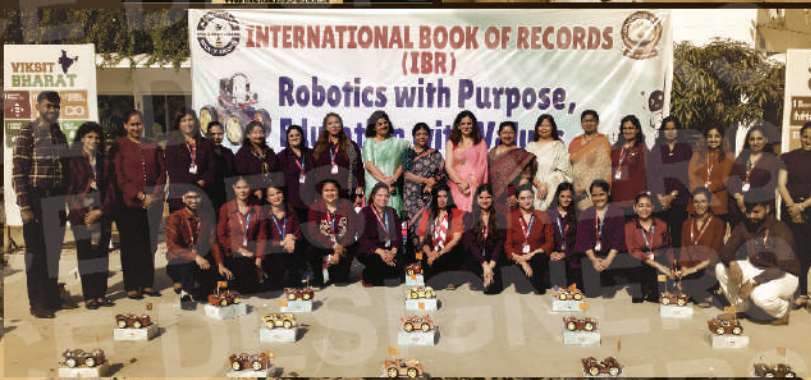
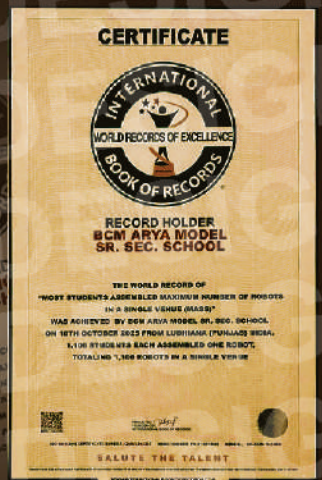
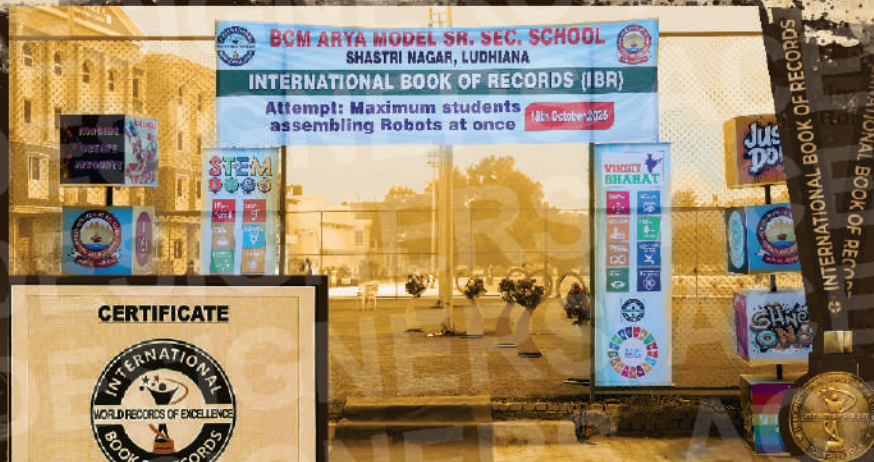

A Train the Trainer session under the Sahyog initiative was conducted for the Ashirwad faculty, focusing on practical teaching approaches across various skill-based disciplines.



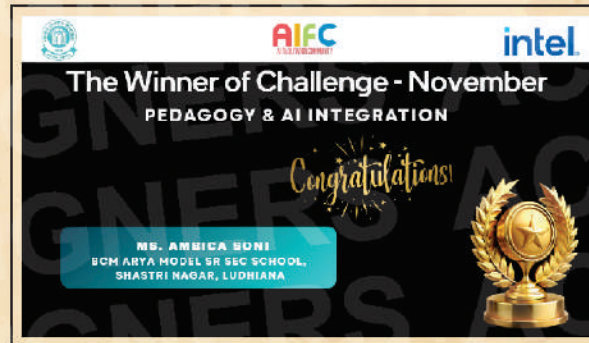

You may not notice it immediately, but when you feel you \*can't study\*, can't focus on anything for more than 30 seconds, or your daily activities start getting affected—that, my friend, is brain rot acting up.

That's your brain signalling that it's overwhelmed.

How to Break the Cycle (Simple Steps That Truly Work):

- Keep your phone outside the room while studying
- Avoid using your phone during meals or conversations
- Stop scrolling the moment you catch yourself saying "just one more"
- Replace one scrolling session with learning a new skill
- Read a few pages every day—anything you enjoy
- Turn off notifications from the apps that distract you the most

These small habits protect your mind—and bring back your focus, energy and spark.

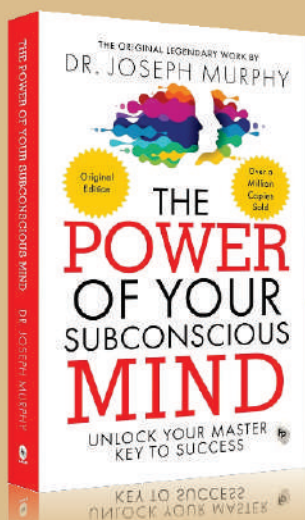

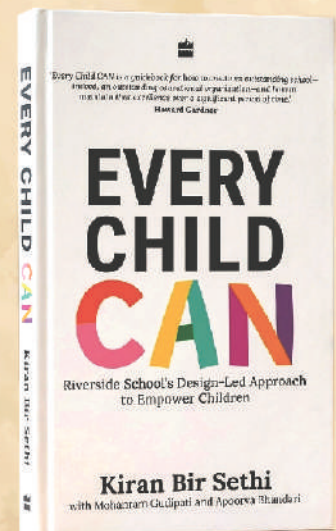
