Dear Parents,

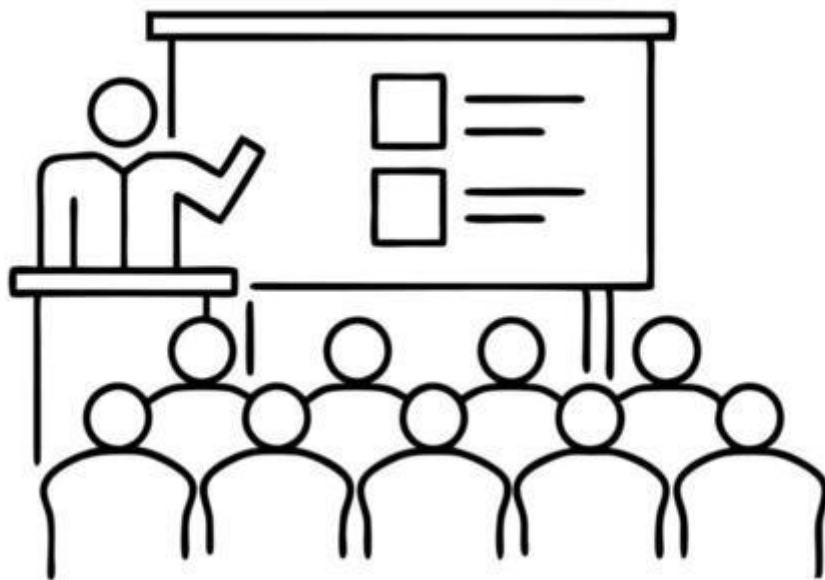

MAY DAY

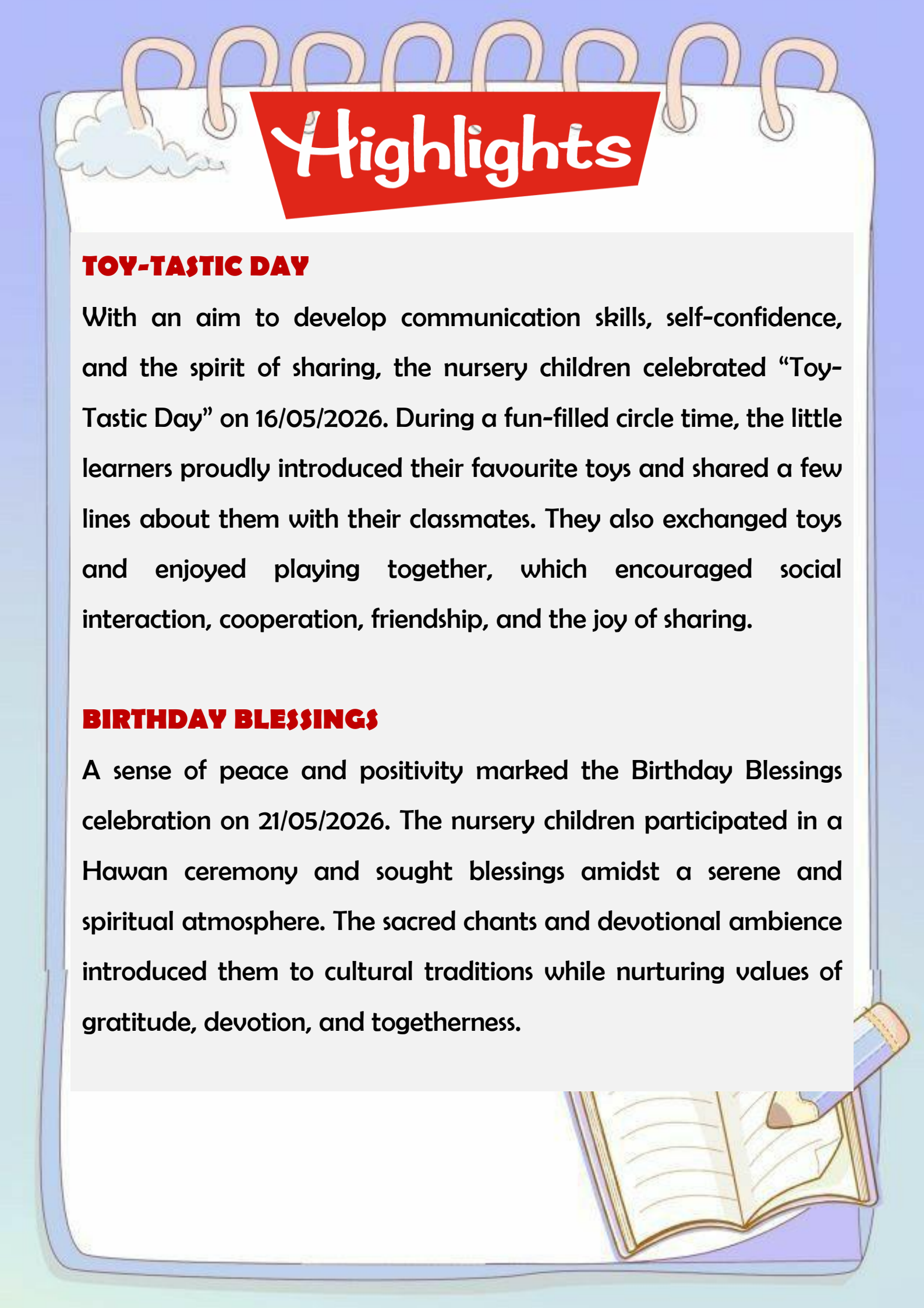
