TIPS FOR PARENTS

1. **Picture Talk:** Encourage children to observe pictures and talk about what they see, name objects and describe simple actions.
2. **Listen to Sounds:** Introduce letter sounds through rhymes, actions, songs and familiar objects in a playful manner.
3. **Book Handling:** Teach children to hold a book properly, turn pages one at a time and follow a story from beginning to end.
4. **Read Aloud Daily:** Share a short picture story every day and encourage children to listen, respond and repeat familiar words.
5. **Read the Environment:** Help children notice familiar letters, symbols and signs around them, such as P for Parking or familiar shop signs.
